

SUPPLY LIST FOR ELI CEDRONES WORKSHOPS

****Students** will need an easel. The half French is great or a Pochade box.

Palette: Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow light, Cadmium Red Light, Viridian, Ultramarine Blue, Pthalo Blue, Quinacridon Pink, Transparent Oxide Red, Transparent Brown or Van Dyke Brown, Ivory Black. **Optional:** Naples Yellow Light, Cadmium Yellow Lemon, Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Yellow Orange, Cad Yellow Medium.

Canvas: Centurion linen panels or Ampersand gesso board. It's a smoother, less absorbent surface than canvas found in art stores. You can also buy cheaper panels and put a coat of gesso over it for better working surface. Buy a variety of standard sizes; 6x8, 8x10, 9x12 - make sure they fit in your Raymar wet paint carrier. If you get the 1/8" panels you can fit two into each slot of the paint carrier.

Brushes: Bristle brushes - flats, rounds and filberts, variety of sizes. I like Silver Brand or Rosemary long synthetic bristle filberts. Smaller brushes for detail. Isabey or Series 274 Masters Choice (mongoose) from Rosemary & Co. Very versatile for blending, washes and detail.

Drawing Materials: Sketch Book 8x10 or smaller, Faber Castell graphite pencils #2900 6B, vine charcoal, black Sharpie pointed marker.

Mineral Spirits: Gamsol odorless spirits (allowed on plane) or Substitute Turp Natural or Zest-It Oil Paint Dilutant and Brush Cleaner.

Painting Medium: Gamblin Solvent Free Gel Medium or Winsor Newton Liquin Gel Medium or whatever you're used to.

Wet Paint Carrier: Raymar made of lightweight corrugated plastic in variety of sizes.

Easels & Pochade Boxes: You'll need a portable easel and carrier with wheels so you can bring all of your gear on location easily.
